PARKS RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations have been condensed from the complete Manchester Village Ordinance, Chapter 15, Section 159.01 to 159.13.

- 1) Parking – Vehicles must be parked in the designated parking areas.
- 2) Dangerous or Obnoxious Materials or Equipment – 1) Obnoxious materials such as, but not limited to garbage, sewage, bottles, cans, refuse, trash, waste, etc. may not be deposited in or on any lands or water areas in any parks or playgrounds, except in receptacles provided for such purposes. 2) Slingshots, pellet guns, air rifles, fireworks, explosives or other dangerous materials are not allowed without a special permit from the Village Council.
- 3) Signs – Signs are not allowed to be posted on any structure, tree or automobile within park boundaries with the exception of temporary directional signs for group events that may be placed on signposts designated for such purposes and must be removed at the end of the event.
- 4) Fires – Fires are not allowed within park boundaries except in picnic stoves (grills), fireplaces or places provided for such a purpose. Hot ashes or burning materials may not be dumped into any trash containers, or elsewhere within the park.
- 5) Pets – Any pet must be kept on a leash not over 6' in length and must be under the immediate control of some responsible person.
- 6) Preservation of Property and Natural Resources – 1) No person shall injure, deface, disturb, defoul or in any manner destroy or cause to be destroyed any portion of any park or playground or any facility, building, sign, structure, equipment, utility or other property found within park boundaries. 2) No person shall dig up, remove, injure or destroy a tree, flower, shrub, plant or any other growing thing or rock, mineral, artifact or any other material within park boundaries.
- 7) Noise – Excessive noise that may disturb the peace of any other individual or the peaceable use of the park is prohibited.
- 8) Disorderly Conduct – Drunken, loud, boisterous, disorderly or indecent conduct, as well as any assault or activity which could endanger or annoy other people, or the peace or good order within the park is prohibited.
