President Vaillencourt called the regular meeting of the Manchester Village Council to order at 9:00am with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Council members present: Vaillencourt, Dresch, Way, Woods, Andrews. Council members absent: Chartrand and DuRussel. Also present were Manager Wallace, Clerk Schaible, Brent Jones (DPW), Sgt Mahalick (WCSD), and Nicholas Steinmetz (MCS).

HOME COMING PARADE- Nicholas Steinmetz, Superintendent of the Manchester Community Schools, requested a rolling closure of Main Street (Clinton St. to Woodland Way), Woodland Way and Dutch Drive (Woodland Way to the High School) to accommodate a Homecoming Parade on October 12th beginning at 5:00pm. Steinmetz explained that a Manchester Township Fire Truck would lead the parade which would include the marching band, the fall sports teams and the homecoming court. It would likely be about a block long and would be staged at the Andrews Chiropractic parking lot. Sgt. Mahalick reported that a patrol car could follow the parade. Steinmetz agreed to work with Brent Jones (DPW) and Sgt. Mahalick to determine barricade needs and provide volunteers to maintain them. A motion was made by Dresch, seconded by Woods, that the request to close Main Street for a homecoming parade on 10/12/18 beginning at 5:00pm be approved with the details as presented. Motion passed.

There being no further business, President Vaillencourt adjourned the meeting at 9:10am.
