APPROVED MINUTES MANCHESTER VILLAGE COUNCIL December 20th, 2021 COUNCIL CHAMBERS-VILLAGE HALL 7:00 PM

President Vailliencourt called the regular meeting of the Manchester Village Council to order at 7:00pm with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Council members present: Chartrand, Way, Dresch, Vailliencourt and Andrews. Council members absent: DuRussel and Woods. Also present were: Manager Wallace; Clerk Schaible; and Sgt. Joel Gebauer (WCSD).

The minutes of the December 6th, 2021 regular meeting were approved on a motion by Dresch, seconded by Way.

AGENDA – The agenda was approved as amended: moving Committee Reports: A) Sheriff to just after Public Participation; and deleting 7A) Lead & Copper Update and Committee Reports: B) Parks; C) Planning Commission; D) DDA; E) Healthy Communities/Wellness Coalition; F) Manchester Community Joint Planning Commission; G) Building; H) Personnel Committee; and I) Finance Committee on a motion by Dresch, seconded by Andrews.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION- None

SPECIAL SESSION CITY-STATUS- Vailliencourt reported that there is nothing new at this time. The plan is to send out a newsletter to Village residents after the first of the year updating them to the current status.

<u>SHERIFF REPORT</u>- Sgt. Gebauer presented and reviewed the Washtenaw County Sheriff's report for November 2021. He also reported that shift bids had resulted in one deputy change.

OLD BUSINESS-

MANAGER SEARCH- Vailliencourt presented the proposals for candidate recruitment from the Michigan Municipal League and Walsh Municipal Services. Wallace reported that, in his research, Walsh has helped a great number of communities and will have many contacts. MML will also be good but is priced significantly higher. A motion was made by Andrews, seconded by Chartrand, that the Village proceed with the manager search using Walsh Municipal Services at a cost not to exceed \$8100. Roll call vote; ayes-all. Motion passed. A motion was made by Andrews, seconded by Way, that Chartrand replace Dresch on the Personnel Committee as Dresch will not be available for the next several months. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS-

<u>LUMINARIES</u>- Council members volunteered to light luminaries in public spaces on Christmas Eve.

<u>ACCOUNTS PAYABLE</u> – Council reviewed the payables list. A motion was made by Dresch, seconded by Way, to approve for payment the list dated 12/20/2021 totaling \$43,964.08. Roll call vote: ayes-all. Motion carried.

REPORTS-

<u>DPW</u>- Wallace presented the report noting that the "new" water meters are approaching 15 years old and are requiring replacement more rapidly.

MANAGER- Wallace reviewed his report highlighting the availability of RAP grants and asking that DDA and Parks review their master plans for opportunities.

At this time, a motion was made by Andrews, seconded by Chartrand, that the Council go into closed session to consider purchase or lease of real property. Roll call vote: ayes-all. Motion carried.
