CITY CHARTER APPROVED

On November 7, 2023, Manchester voters approved the proposed City Charter that created the City of Manchester. All filings were completed on November 15, 2023 that allowed for the newly created City of Manchester to exist. The Mayor and City Councilmembers were sworn into office on November 20, 2023.

TAX BILLS FOR WINTER 2023

- Taxpayers within the City of Manchester will be receiving tax bills for Winter 2023 from Manchester Township. Even though the Village of Manchester has become the City of Manchester, taxpayers are still liable for one (1) more tax bill from Manchester Township with those millages assessed upon taxpayers.
- The reason for this is due to the General Property Tax Act and the date that 2023 property tax assessments and millages are determined. That date is December 31, 2022, which is commonly referred to as Tax Day. Since the City of Manchester was still the Village of Manchester on December 31, 2022, it is recognized as such for the entire year of 2023 as the Village of Manchester due to its status on Tax Day in 2022.
- Summer 2024 and Winter 2024 tax bills will be issued by the City of Manchester and payable at the Manchester City Offices at 912 City Road.

WATER AND WASTEWATER REPORTS FOR OCTOBER 2023

Drinking Water

- 5,679,000 gals produced and treated with Chlorine and Fluoride for an average Free Chlorine residual of 0.76mg/L, Fluoride residual of 0.71mg/L, and Iron residual of 0.02mg/L after filtering.
- No violations in the treatment or distribution of the City of Manchester drinking water.

<u>Wastewater</u>

- 7,750,000 gals treated and discharged to the River Raisin.
- All treated sewage tested within the MI-EGLE permitted values with no violations
- The new headworks building for screening and grit removal is up and running. The benefits of the new headworks include less pump failures and increased life expectancy of wastewater pumps and equipment.
